

# FIDE ARBITERS SEMINAR IN TERME CATEZ, SLOVENIA

With the cooperation of the Slovenian Chess Federation and FIDE Development Commission, the European Chess Union organized a “Mixed” FIDE Arbiters’ Seminar in the English language.

The venue was the city of Terme Čatež, Slovenia, concurrently with the European Team Championship. The event took place from Sunday, Nov. 14th, to Thursday, Nov. 18th, 2021.

The lecturer of the Seminar was Ms. Jiřina Prokopová, International Arbiter and FIDE Lecturer.

The Seminar could have been followed online or in person from the city of Terme Catez. In total, 15 participants took part in the event.

The Seminar has covered following themes:

- >Laws of Chess (Including Rapid&Blitz)
- >Competition rules and standards of chess equipment
- >Anti-cheating guidelines
- >Regulations for the rating and the over-the-board titles
- >Regulations for the titles of the Arbiters
- >Use of Electronic clocks
- >System of games and tiebreaks
- >Swiss system and pairing rules

By the end of the lectures, participants had an examination test, and two participants have passed it.
